The Lancaster and Westmorland Medical Journal is an extension of the local programme of postgraduate education. Its aims are to further medical education, improve clinical practice and foster medical research in the area served by the Lancaster and Kendal hospitals. The journal publishes articles which are of specific relevance to the locality. A wide range of subjects is covered including clinical practice, organisation of services, disease prevention, research, management and medical history. Well documented case reports are also considered for publication. The journal welcomes correspondence on matters of current interest as well as commentary on previous articles. Additional features include a news section, a quiz, a list of library acquisitions and the postgraduate diary.

Manuscripts and all editorial correspondence should be sent to The Editor, Lancaster and Westmorland Medical Journal, Postgraduate Centre, Royal Lancaster Infirmary, Lancaster. Articles should be prepared in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (Br Med J 1988; 296: 401-405). They should be typed, double spaced, on A4 paper with wide margins.

The journal is produced three times a year and is sent free of charge to every medical practitioner in the area served by the Lancaster and Kendal hospitals. The cost of publication and distribution is borne in part by Lancaster Health Authority and in part by sponsorship, subscription and advertising revenue. A list of sponsors appears on the inside back cover. The cost of subscription is £30 per annum.
